In order to receive the University High Endorsement, students must complete the following:

- ✓ 28 credits
- ✓ 3.0 cumulative GPA (as of December of the graduation year)
- ✓ 1 credit (120 hours) of community service
- ✓ Complete a minimum of 6 AP exams
- ✓ Earn a minimum of 30 college credits
- ✓ Meet all PUSD graduation requirements in addition to completing the following courses:
