

# **FALCON FEATHERS**

The Foothills Falcon Feathers document is a way for our school to express the expectations for a great Foothills learning experience and overall expected behavior We are a signature school in the Peoria Unified School District with a focus on the fine arts. This is our school's first year of practicing a very planned *Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support (PBIS)* for our students and staff. This committee of Foothills' staff has developed expectations that our students, staff, and parents will be committed to. We want all kids to be successful in the public education system. This word "success" is about academics *and* the social emotional well-being of all Foothills' students.

This idea of the Falcon Feathers was inspired by the Ron Clark Academy (RCA) in Atlanta, Georgia. Members of our committee were sent to RCA in 2016 and came back inspired with great ideas to make our school stronger. The staff also brought back a program we became passionate about: our House program at Foothills. The Falcon Feathers was created to allow all stakeholders to commit to the success of every student in this school climate and culture. We believe that when a falcon grows, the more feathers they have, the stronger they will fly and lead the eyrie (group/flock) of Falcons. We want ALL of our Foothills Falcons to be leaders in their own way! We are thankful for this inspirational opportunity to do as much as we can for our community.

Please read through this document as you can see the connections to the SCHOOL STRUCTURE, you will get great sense of our SCHOOL CULTURE, and ALL stakeholders will have a good opportunity to provide AGENCY (actions and intervention) to really enact these ideas to make children better here at school, better at home, and of course, better for their future!

# **STUDENT FALCON FEATHERS**

#### Habits/ Life lessons we hope to instill in students that transcend beyond their years at Foothills. These feathers will add to their strength to S.O.A.R as a Falcon.

- 1. Believe in the arts and EXPLORE your CREATIVITY.
- 2. Follow all the SOAR expectations. Being a great FALCON, will earn you invaluable experiences.
- 3. Cheer for your fellow FALCONS and celebrate their successes.
- 4. Love your HOUSE and represent it with PRIDE. Wear your house colors on designated days.
- 5. Exercise your IMAGINATION, increase CONCENTRATION, and embrace COOPERATION
- 6. What you give is what you will get. **POSITIVE** energy and **HARDWORK** will be returned to you.
- 7. Work to UNDERSTAND others' views and EXPLORE new ideas
- 8. Appreciate that every Foothills Falcon is different. **RESPECT** that everyone is different from you.
- 9. Be polite to all. Greet others with a smile. Say "please" and "thank you"
- 10. Be a FRIEND to get a friend. Welcome others to sit with you and invite others to play with you.
- 11. **STAND TOGETHER** against bullies. Never tolerate it at our school, and let it be known, loud and clear, when you are unhappy with treatment that you witness. Report any bully incident.
- 12. Mentor the younger classmates in your HOUSE and realize your responsibility to keep the FALCON energy positive and traditions alive!
- 13. HONOR your character outside of school when using social media. INSPIRE by sharing positive stories. Realize that nothing is ever really gone once it has been posted.
- 14. Keep your INTEGRITY: Do the right thing even when no one is watching.
- 15. Always tell the truth and OWN YOUR CHOICES. Don't risk breaking the Tower of Trust you have built.
- 16. Apologize with a deep sense of **SINCERITY** and really mean it.
- 17. ACCEPT correction and advice from others. Seek to grow from it.
- 18. In learning, take a RISK and know that FAILURE is about learning more. PERSISTENCE will get you closer to your goal. Keep a growth mindset; we have "grit and do not quit!"
- 19. Ask for help when needed. It's okay not to know, but not okay to not try.
- 20. Demonstrate GRATITUDE often in positive and meaningful ways.
- 21. Begin with GENEROSITY and your kindness will be seen by others.
- 22. Realize it's not all about you. FAIRNESS doesn't mean everyone getting the same thing. Fairness is everyone getting what they need.
- 23. Be a GOOD SPORT by winning and losing gracefully.
- 24. Seek to know your teachers and ALL staff members better. You are responsible for the student-staff bond as well.
- 25. Show APPRECIATION to staff and thank your teachers for great lessons at the end of the class period.
- 26. Use **PATIENCE** with others. You do not know everyone's story.
- 27. Be a good citizen. Show PRIDE in keeping the school and environment clean.
- 28. Stay curious. Constantly THINK and WONDER. Never stop learning.
- 29. Dare to EXPLORE your DREAMS. "Only ones who can see the invisible can do the impossible."

# **PARENT FALCON FEATHERS**

- 1. BREATHE and realize that all Foothills staff come to work each day for your child. We want them to grow academically and to become strong citizens. YOUR CHILD is our FUTURE!
- 2. Be INVOLVED in parent events to support your child and their school.
- 3. TRUST our plans to provide for a POSITIVE learning environment. The decisions we make are for the social/emotional well-being of your child.
- 4. Be mindful that receiving an award is not the only way a child is recognized for success.
- 5. Be focused on your child getting a good EDUCATION rather than your child getting good grades.
- 6. Understand that grades aren't given; they are **EARNED** and allow Foothills to challenge your child.
- 7. Understand that Foothills is **COMMITTED** to provide your child with a well-rounded education.
- 8. Take ideas to Dr. Benson or Mr. Vail.
- 9. EMBRACE opportunities to provide FEEDBACK to the school to make things better
- 10. ENCOURAGE your child to problem solve. However, if there is a problem, please let the teacher/staff member know.
- 11. Help your child, in a reasonable way, to provide them opportunities to solve their OWN problem.
- 12. Realize that there is **OFTEN** more than one perspective about a problem.
- 13. If there is a problem, work in **PARTNERSHIP** with Foothills teacher/staff to resolve.
- 14. Don't make excuses for your child.
- 15. CONTRIBUTE no more than 15% of the ideas and work to any of your child's projects or papers.
- 16. Realize that every child has different INTELLIGENCES and your input will help us serve your child.
- 18. Work with your child and their teacher to **SUPPORT** important academic skills.
- 19. Show APPRECIATION to the teachers and staff often.
- 20. Be ON TIME for school in the morning and when picking up your child.
- 21. Never pick up your child early from school unless for a doctor's appointment or an urgent major event.
- 22. Consistently CHECK on your child's ACADEMIC PROGRESS, with the teacher, Parent VUE, and attend conferences.
- 23. Thoroughly read/listen to all COMMUNICATIONS; emails and/or calls from the school.
- 24. Be **PATIENT** in the car lines while dropping off/picking-up your child.
- 25. SPEAK POSITIVELY about staff members and Foothills in front of your child at all times.
- 26. Keep social media posts **POSITIVE**.
- 27. Be MINDFUL that fair and equal are not the same thing.
- 28. ATTEND and support Foothills children and other school competitors while performing in school events.
- 29. CHEER appropriately and respectfully for all performers/athletes/coaches/referees.
- 30. On campus, ENCOURAGE your child to be SAFE, OWN their choice, have a great ATTITUDE, and be RESPECTFUL to all.

#### **School Culture**

- 1. Choose to be HAPPY. Uplift your fellow staff members and students. Ask people how they are doing. Show sincere interest and mean it.
- 2. Realize you are part of an evolution in education. Be down for it and **CONTRIBUTE** to its impact.
- 3. Love your HOUSE and represent it with PRIDE. Wear your house colors on designated days.
- 4. Embody our mission, "ARTFUL TEACHING, ARTFUL LEARNING."

#### **Classroom Culture**

- 5. Create an inviting classroom where students are **EXCITED** to be at school and excited to learn.
- 6. Seek a bond with every child and see their potential. Recognize and respect the MULTIPLE INTELLIGENCES that support students learning in different ways.
- 7. Be innovative and bold in your plans and actions. Use ENGAGEMENT strategies for students to PARTICIPATE, COLLABORATE, and THINK in their learning moments.
- 8. Connect learning to previous student experiences or content knowledge and apply that learning to REAL WORLD applications.
- 10. Teach METACOGNITION STRATEGIES, so students have an awareness of their own thought processes.
- 11. Inspire a WORK ETHIC within our students.
- 12. Give **PRAISE** to the work the students are doing. Offer specific feedback to ALL students.
- 13. Keep your promises to students; if you tell them you are going to do something, it must happen.
- 14. Work with your team to create a consistent grade level behavior reward system with a rippling effect to the school wide HOUSE program.
- 15. COMMUNICATE regularly with families to build teacher student family RELATIONSHIPS.
- 16. Control your own voice volume and tone when redirecting student behavior.
- 17. Be a MENTOR to students. Be consistent and FAIR with discipline.
- 18. Embrace the school wide behavior plan as it was created to ensure support and success for ALL students.
- 19. Parents may not agree with what you are doing. LISTEN, EXPLAIN, and WORK with a parent. Report concerns to administration.

#### **Staff Culture**

- 20. Choose not to complain or gossip. Go right to the source of a problem when there is an issue. **POSITIVE** energy will be returned to you.
- 21. Dress professionally within the expectations of the Peoria Unified School District.
- 22. Seek opportunities to GROW personally and professionally.
- 23. Respectfully accept constructive feedback.
- 24. Don't worry about failure in your risk taking. LEARN from these moments and make them better.
- 25. Warning students that you will tell Dr. Benson or Mr. Vail if they don't behave, takes away your authority.
- 27. Keep all spaces neat and organized.
- 28. Be **RESPECTFUL** of others during meetings. Be punctual and track the speaker in the same way we ask our students to do.
- 29. If there is an ongoing problem that cannot be resolved after multiple attempts, seek help from administration.

# FOOTHILLS HOUSE PROGRAM

The HOUSE system is a tradition that creates a very productive and vibrant part of the school's culture. integral The House system is designed to reflect and enhance the values of Foothills Fine Arts Academy as they are described in the Foothills Mission and Vision statement.

The core values are explained as <u>CREATING</u>, <u>DREAMING</u>, <u>EXPLORING</u>, <u>OPTIMIZING</u>, and <u>PERSISTING</u>. Together, these aspects make up the core values, philosophy, ideology of the school and they give us our clear direction and pathway.

The HOUSE program is designed like Harry Potter's school, Hogwarts. Each HOUSE has a key word as the name, a symbol, color, and related to a global culture. The key words are the characteristics we envisioned for our future.

#### **Benefits for Students:**

- It allows students to have an opportunity to interact with students from all grade levels in their HOUSE. It increases opportunities for student leadership.
- It allows students to participate in a variety of activities that are non-academic and non-athletic.
- It is a wonderful way to know more people outside of the classroom setting.
- It can be a source of positive peer-pressure and motivation that can have a positive effect in the classroom.
- Marquee events bring more fans to athletic and fine arts events.
- Studies show that schools with HOUSE systems have happier students and have more school spirit than they did before a HOUSE system was implemented.
- Students have the opportunity to engage with HOUSE faculty mentors.

#### What does it mean to be a HOUSE member?

Members of a house, work together to promote and recognize the house characteristics of **EXPLORING** (taking calculated risks), PERSISTING, CREATING, DREAMING (developing great ideas), and OPTIMIZING (being positive and inspiring). When a HOUSE member observes their HOUSE characteristic from ANY house member, they should publicly recognize their fellow students, and if necessary, write a recommendation for a Flying Falcon Feather(F3) Recognition. An F3 is a recognition of students that have exemplified, in a significant way, the characteristics of the HOUSE system. HOUSE members always help other HOUSE members. Reaching out and encouraging positive and productive actions and behaviors for the best Foothills culture.

#### What is HOUSE Leadership?

There will be a variety of HOUSE leaders. These will mostly start with 4th graders and moving up.

- Student Council HOUSE Members 6th, 7th, 8th grade (3 students per house) = 15 Students (VOTED IN by House members)
- Welcome Committee 1st –8th grade. 40 Children
- Chant/Dance Committee 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade
- Spirit Committee- 1st –8th grade

#### How does a student become a member in a HOUSE?

When a new student arrives to Foothills, we will have a very brief welcome ceremony. Parents, we encourage you to stick around! Here the students will spin our HOUSE wheel and instantly become a member. Kindergarten students will do this process in December. At the beginning of the school year, we conduct a welcome back assembly in which ALL new student's 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade spin into a HOUSE.

# **PUSD PBIS GENERAL PLAN**


Peoria Unified School District's Social Emotional Learning Initiative is an inclusive and comprehensive multi-tiered system of support designed to be proactive in response to the social and emotional needs of all students, Pre-K-12th grade. Foothills will have its own system, data, and support for our students. Below is a general PUSD plan for all schools.

Tier 1 STUDENT Plan - At the tier I level as with our vision, "Every Student, Every day" ALL students will have access to a safe and welcoming environment, behavioral expectations, a caring adult, family involvement, restorative practices, and social emotional training. -

Tier 2 STUDENT Plan - At the tier II level, students who are in need of additional support will be provided access to intensive services and support by our school social workers and other support staff.

Tier 3 STUDENT Plan- At the tier III level, if there is a need, our district has a system of support for students provided by our Special Education Department as well as a group of community partners we have collaborated with to provide additional resources for the family.

Recognizing that the social emotional needs of our students is a collaborative effort, we have established six funnels of support to include: District, School, Teacher, Student, Parent, and Community. <u>CLICK HERE FOR THE PUSD PBIS PLAN</u>



## **FOOTHILLS PBIS PLAN**

Tier 1- This is mostly what you are reading about. This includes and focuses on ALL students. This includes our (parent, student, staff) commitment (Falcon Feathers), our Foothills HOUSE program, our visual images of our S.O.A.R expectations in all parts of the campus, the school wide culture and climate, to make the kids feel like they are safe and academically successful! This involves learning about the behavior expectations each day.

This is a more specific program to help SOME kids with specific needs related to their behavior and social and emotional well-being. This is operated by our school wide social worker, school psychologist, and school administration. It involves action plans for adult behavior responses. This involves learning moments for kids and regular check ins and connections to particular staff. The programs are more linear and specific program operations. In this level we work and partner with parents as well to ensure growth on specific needs.

This level of support involves very intense follow up and specific program implementation to help a FEW children. This can involve our Child Study Team, outside resources if necessary, and more focus work with our school psychologist and social worker.

## **CONCRETE PAINT LINES**



When a student sees a red line, they should be ready and responsible for running on the playground areas to be SAFE and HEALTHY. Kids will follow the PLAYGROUND S.O.A.R expectations.



## YELLOW- YIELD! WAIT AND WALK!

These are yellow lines in our morning wait area. The kids are PATIENT and wait until a bell rings to allow students to go the AM playground areas. Then they follow the WALKWAY S.O.A.R expectations.

## REWARDS AND POSITIVE REINFORCEMENTS FOR STUDENTS, STAFF, PARENTS, AND COMMUNITY

Honor Roll- Three times a year, student in the 5th -8th grade levels will be recognized for their GPA of 3.5 and above.

<u>Principals List</u>- Three times a year, students in the 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade levels will be recognized for their GPA to be at 4.0.

<u>S.O.A.R Award-</u> Three times a year, teachers will recommend students to be recognized for their S.O.A.R behavior K-8. Students in Kindergarten through 4<sup>th</sup> grade will attend an Award Assembly. Students in the 5<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade will be recognized at the Honor Roll assembly.

<u>S.O.A.R Chips-</u> These chips are given to kids for their S.O.A.R decisions. Each chip is 1 point. They turn their SOAR Chip into the office chip collection tubes and write their name down to win a 2 week drawing for a prize.

<u>Two Week S.O.A.R rewards-</u> Every two weeks, a drawing of students who received a S.O.A.R chip and brought it to the office will be announced to come to the office and receive a toy prize or a chance to have Pizza with the Principal.

F3 (Flying Falcon Feather) Recognition- This is a student recommendation. Students will have the opportunity to celebrate a fellow Falcon who displays the characteristics of S.O.A.R or any HOUSE characteristic. The HOUSE characteristics that may be seen are PERSISTING, EXPLORING (taking calculated risks), CREATING, DREAMING (developing great ideas), and OPTIMIZING (being positive and inspiring). This student, who recommended the celebration, can request a Bright Feather form that will be collected by administration and recognized at the planned HOUSE TEAM Event.

<u>WEEKLY Classroom S.O.A.R Chip Reward and Recognition Systems -</u> Teachers in a grade level using their own classroom HOUSE reward system (token economy, marble or cloud jars, clip charts, etc.) will provide a Gold (50), Silver (25), Bronze (15) chip to reward to the school wide HOUSE Point system. They will reward a House Hero for their great work with a Pink chip for 100 HOUSE points.

<u>VISITOR CHIPS-</u> We have green chips that any visitor on the campus can reward a student for doing something really well. This chip is a 5-point chip for the student's HOUSE.

<u>HOUSE Points</u>- Chips that are turned in by the students will be counted in the office. Each week there will be communication as to how the HOUSE points are increasing. Each quarter there is a HOUSE (K-8) that will be rewarded for leading the school.

<u>Positive Feedback</u>- Staff should continually offer positive feedback to great behavior that meets the school expectation. Students may earn the pink S.O.A.R chip (25) from a staff member for excellence or improved effort.

<u>Volunteer Recognition</u>- Each year we will nominate the PUSD parent volunteer from Foothills to the district level. Foothills would like to find a great way to celebrate ALL volunteers from our school each year in a fun and creative way. We also want our volunteers to feel involved in our HOUSE program. Students may earn the green S.O.A.R chip (10) from a volunteer for excellence or improved effort.

HOUSE Awards- Each quarter the HOUSE that wins the points system will have a celebratory moment with all HOUSE members K-8.

<u>8<sup>th</sup> Grade Promotion</u>- This is a recognition of students who have finished 8<sup>th</sup> grade ready to attend the high school level program


