Budget discussion revolved around the Title I funds and the transition of funding and potential purchase for materials in the classroom, the purchase of technology, and other district wide programs for literacy and math. The next couple of weeks Dr. Benson will work with Title I Department to finalize the budget for the remainder of the year. There was discussion of Social and Emotional curriculum purchased by the Title I funds. I had looked into this with the Be Kind presentation and it was not accepted, however, there were questions about these from other admin and schools.

Also, the opening of Junior High positions was discussed. Some open enrollment questions were also asked about adding students and when. Dr. Benson mentioned that we will be monitoring the numbers often of new enrollees and open enrollments from outside the district to ensure we can enroll with the amount of teachers e have hired.

- o The committee reviewed the BeKind Survey results from the 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade. Many committee chats occurred about the interesting and thoughtful comments and relation to the short survey results from the last meeting and any significant differences in the results.
- o The discussion of the call out to the community about the Volunteering program and that there was no sign up for it. There was discussion about how we can get this to work. Open discussion and not very focused. Dr. Benson Mentioned maybe a more organized initiative starting this summer for next school year.
- o Reviewed the CAN process for Title I goals and the ideas of staff feedback and the process of developing a whole view of goals. The process with staff was mentioned and that the principal did the entire assessment. There were not big differences from the staff to the principal. There was a review of the Family and Community Feedback section and rubric with the Site Council and provided the committee to review the areas, rate them, and the drop off the survey back at school or send it with their child in their back pack (teacher can send it up to the office too).
- The 21st Century Grant was briefly presented and the concepts of the Community Engagement activities that could be a part of our grant process. Ideas such as social and emotional programs, athletics for kids, interventions for math and Reading skills, and programs for learning moments for students (STEM, Makerspace, etc.). Parents thought of some parent classes on children behavior, even classes in music or dance, and also intervention help in reading and math skills for home.
- The committee reviewed the SOAR chart that outlined particular SOAR behavior expectations in different contexts such as the cafeteria, restroom, classroom, etc.
- Ideas for making particular SOAR posters for the area like the cafeteria or playground might be easier to refer too.
- Principal was going to research some poster and sign development by a vendor and potential cost.

WHO: Open to youth in grades K-6 or ages 5-12 who have a social, emotional, or behavioral health challenge that is interfering with school. GKC is open to youth living with biological, adoptive and foster parents as well as kinship caregivers. AHCCCS enrollment is required.

WHEN: Tuesdays and Thursdays, after school until 7pm. Additional program days and hours are offered during Fall, Winter, and Spring breaks as well as the first and third Saturdays of the month.

academic learning and other school activities, including ensuring: 1. Family Engagement Opportunities (ESSA, Sec. 8101(39)) - Participation of parents in regular, two-way and meaningful communication involving student

- That parents play an integral role in assisting their child's learning;
- That parents are encouraged to be actively involved in their child's education in afterschool and school; and
- That parents are full partners in their child's education and are included, as appropriate, in decision making and on advisory committees to assist in the education of their child.

2. Family Literacy and Related Services (ESSA, Sec. 8101(24)) - Services provided to families that are of sufficient intensity in terms of hours, and of sufficient duration, to make sustainable changes in a family, and that integrate the following activities:

- Interactive literacy activities between parents and their children;
- Training for parents regarding how to be the primary teacher for their children and full partners in the education of their children; and
- Parent literacy training that leads to economic self-sufficiency.




- Be based on the needs of the family through surveys, focus groups and family input;

- Be the culture of the campus.








