- o Reviewed only Foothills suspension reports as the current referral data may not be so impactful to review due to the last meeting date and the school break in December. What was discussed was the differences between all elementary schools and the areas of our suspension reports. There was not a significant difference in our reporting than other schools. The total numbers over 33 elementary schools was also a focus.
- o Reviewed enrollment and our future to staff the school and the potential loss of staff due to current numbers, policy on staffing and numbers, and the other variable of employment such as retirement, certification, etc.
- o Reviewed the safety concept of the lock down shared documents and the goal to ensure we have all students accountable for in a lock down crisis. The Council was informed of a safety audit by the district.

- o_Many discussions of the idea of the cafeteria structure and the seating that is now different and perhaps more productive. Some council members have received good feedback from their students. One student at the meeting was good with the seating.
- o Discussion of information of why it was changed in the past. Efficiency of set up, health, negative interactions with others. There was some feedback that it was quieter in the cafeteria the first day of the new seating.
- o Discussion on scheduling and the complexity of lunch and the classroom expectations along with teacher prep and a better schedule for arts, PE, etc. Discussion of the long line students wait for in JH. This was due to a schedule change and younger and older kids in line together as well as too many students in a line waiting for lunch. Some brief discussion on limiting classroom schedules by 5 minutes to see if we can impactfully add to lunch time.
- o Members do believe there could be more efficacy in the process of coding in their accounts and the lunch line and time in lunch can be more productive. Perhaps with scan cards for ALL students.
- o Students not finishing their lunch was a question and discussion and leaving before they are done. They can sit and eat if they need to. Staff has not seen a significant issue with this except the beginning of the year and the getting use to a repetitive cycle of the day as well as even days with food kids enjoy like friend chicken.

- The golf program was brought up again to see if we could do it at Cactus HS in the extra gym space. PE was looking into this.






