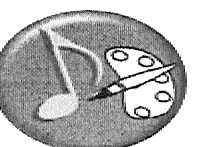
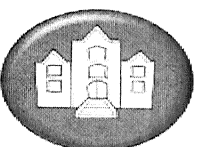

- *Review of disciplinary reports from the extension of the 2018-19 school year in reflection of the same time frame of November to February in 2018-19 from 2017-18. No significant differences in numbers. Desire is to have less referrals than in 2017-18 as it is calculated in the report. Discussed some connections to the Be Kind program and the principal's efforts in some opportunities to have student reflect on Be kind rather than giving a referral.*
- *Review of the new lockdown alarm system added after the winter break. The siren sound and automaticity of the action is very productive.*
- *Enrollment documentation was not available due to absence of our registrar. Discussion of Principal not seeing a significant difference in enrollment from the students who unenrolled before break to the additions in after break.*

- Initiative monitoring
 - Be Kind Survey Results
 - *The Be Kind survey results were explained as not 100% completed by the 4th-8th grade due to other events that were happening in classes such as the Patriotic Speech contest. We reviewed the junior high surveys and saw some good feedback. There was an error in the survey set up and 30 students were completing 2 questions this week. Overall, the results were telling of the presentation and the potential impact. Some questions about some of the questions reviewed were not on the survey. Some of these questions were designed for the May survey to see if there was an impact in some meaningful way the rest of the school year. Available results will be provided in next site council meeting agenda.*
 - Community Suggestions
 - Watch Dog Program
 - Safety audit results and actions
 - *The Watch Dog program was reviewed in request of the last few meetings. The school that was called (Skyview) talked to the principal about the program and how they are trying to implement it. The principal is new and is learning more about it. Dr. Benson was ok with the programs but desired a community member to organize the program. There was a cost of the program initiating (\$400). Principal was fine with that cost. Discussion between community members about the program occurred. Other related conversations about the volunteerism of the community and the desire to have more parents come in and help. The conversation of specific volunteer times was a desire, so parents felt productive. The concept of volunteering in the school lunch time and playground for 1 hour a day will be a start in the near future. There will also be a sign up on the web site.*

Further discussion on bullet points

- *Discussion of summer school and the Title I funding. Foothills will not be conducting summer school for the 2018-19 school year. We desire to start a Kick Start Program where we have opportunity to assess children levels of strength, create intervention plans, SLO goals, and start quality instruction early in August.*
- *Desire some STEAM/STEM opportunities from our community. Also related conversations about the 21st Century Grant and the opportunity for the community provide some productive "courses" such as this for kids. Other programs for community may involve things like dance, Yoga, reading intervention at home and even parental guidance in raising children. MANY opportunities to make not only kids better academically, but families and community connections to the school stronger.*

- Discussion of SOAR program and communication of the concepts in the school. There was discussion of how the program was broken down into a one 'tabled' document to communicate the variety of concepts. Discussion of consistency of usage.

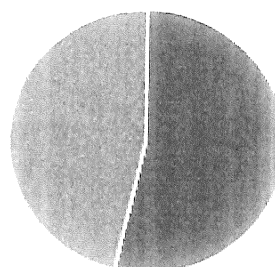

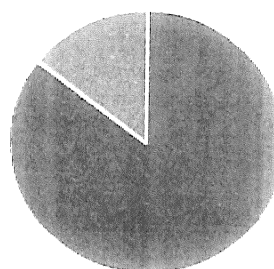
1. Do you worry about Foothills students being unkind to you and other classmates?

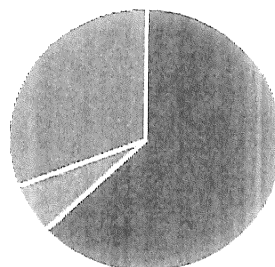

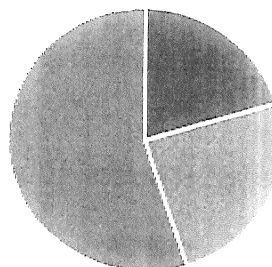
5. After the assembly, do you feel YOU can be more kind to your Foothills classmates?
