 - a. Tax Credits:
 - i. **Approval of spending Greatest Needs Money** Only needed to move \$157.55 from Greatest Needs to Character Ed. A recent Tax Credit for \$200.00 was allocated to Character Ed. A journal entry was submitted but has not been posted yet for \$157.55. Angela will report at our next meeting in May on status of journal entry.
 - **ii. Recommendations for purchases** Found out from the District that we are able to purchase basketball uniforms and pay for field trips. We are not able to purchase band instruments, shade structures or computers. We will ask again about purchasing a new curtain in the MPR and ask about tables in the library since most of our after school events take place in the Library. - ii. **Current needs** We discussed the safety hazards of the amphitheater area. We talked about filling in the lower portion of the amphitheater with concrete which can be very costly. We also talked about the possibility of adding bars along the top edge of the amphitheater and gates at each opening. We will look into these options further and discuss our finding as our next meeting.
