


BACKGROUND - FISCAL YEAR 2021

Facility Master Planning Committee

Purpose: Evaluate study findings and district enrollment, financial, and operational data to identify district school(s) that may have an opportunity for repurposing.

Scope: The committee was to evaluate only school facilities and will limit recommendations to identification of site(s) with potential for repurposing.

Recommendation: The committee and staff recommended that the following schools be considered for repurposing - Pioneer, Desert Palms and Sky View Elementary Schools





BACKGROUND - FISCAL YEAR 2022


School Repurposing Team

Purpose: Explore the options for how to repurpose the three potential school sites and make a recommendation to the Superintendent.

Scope: The team is to evaluate and explore only the three potential school facilities that were recommended for repurposing.

Recommendation: The team recommended that if the three schools were to be repurposed, that they be repurposed into:

- Technology Community/Staff Training Center
- Traditional School
- Alternative Education Center

FIRST OPTION – TRADETHE LAND

- Neutral Cash Flow
- Fiscal Responsibility to district taxpayers
- Gain property in an enrollment growth area for a future new high school



SECOND OPTION - REPURPOSE THE BUILDINGS

- Technology Community/Staff Training Center
- Traditional School w/ Higher Education Partnerships and Centralized Gifted Programs
- Alternative Education Center



SECOND OPTION - REPURPOSE THE BUILDINGS TECHNOLOGY COMMUNITY/STAFF TRAINING CENTER

Possible Program Options

- E-Campus Relocation
- Technology Focused Learning Support Center
- Teaching Studio Spaces for multiple content areas
- Family Welcome Center w/ Centralized Registration
- Family Resource Center
- Copy Center Relocation and Expansion of Services
- Curriculum Resource Warehouse (Textbook and manipulative kits)



SECOND OPTION - REPURPOSE THE BUILDINGS NEW TRADITIONAL SCHOOL

Possible Program Options

- New Traditional School
- Centralized Gifted Program



SECOND OPTION - REPURPOSE THE BUILDINGS ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION CENTER

Possible Program Options

- Alternative Elementary School
 - 6-7-8 Program
 - K-8 Program
- Emotional Disability (Private Day School-EDP)



THIRD OPTION - SELL THE LAND

Process

- Follow Arizona Revised Statutes: 15-341, 15-342 & 15-491
- Governing Board Action Item to close a school or schools
- Governing Board Action Item to sell the property/land
- The sale of property/land must be placed on an election ballot and approved by voters



RECOMMENDATION

Trade The Land

Administration seeks feedback to actively engage land developers in pursuing an agreement

PHASE 4 STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS, PER A.R.S. § 15-341 AND 15-342

Request to Arizona School Facilities Board for approval to reduce the amount of allocated "pupil square footage". SFB approval must be received prior to taking action.

Public hearing(s) to discuss proposed school closure(s):

- Must provide written notice of public hearings to parents or guardians of all students enrolled in the district at least 10 days prior to the public hearing(s).
- Hearing(s) must take place at least 10 days prior to the Board voting on proposed closure(s).


Public hearing(s) to discuss proposed changes to attendance boundaries:

- Must provide written notification of proposed changes to parents or guardians of all students who would be affected by the proposed changes. 10-day calendar timing is the same as for school closure hearings.
- Notifications and hearings may occur simultaneously with school closure notifications and hearings.

Online application to the Arizona Department of Education to terminate any closed schools' "CTDS" numbers.

PHASE 4 ATTENDANCE BOUNDARY CHANGE PROCESS

- Form Committee
 - Form one committee and view the district as whole
 - Area 2 Boundary Changes
 - Area 3 and Area 4 Boundary Changes
- Committee would review multiple boundary options
- Hold Public Hearings for community feedback
- Committee would make a recommendation
- Seek Governing Board approval
