We hope this finds you and your family healthy and well. We are hopeful that one of our teachers was able to connect with you this week and that we are beginning to address the many questions you likely have as we continue to support your child.

We understand that the COVID-19 pandemic is impacting our families in many unique ways. Our goal is to provide you with flexible options so your student has access to continued learning at home through guidance and support. Our teachers will be providing content experiences and online instruction to support individual student needs.

Starting **Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup>**, we will begin offering resources to support learning at home. You will be hearing from your teacher via email, on or before Monday, regarding how they will be offering resources and supporting learning at home for core subject areas and electives.

- For those families without access to a device at home, we have made arrangements for laptop checkout, for use at home, through the closure. From 2:30 p.m. 5:30 p.m. on Monday, March 30, laptops for elementary school students may be checked out from Peoria High School.
- Additional times are available from 7:30 a.m. 10:30 a.m. and from 2 p.m. 4 p.m. on Tuesday, March 31 at Centennial and Liberty high schools.
