Each year, teachers spend a lot of classroom time assessing each child on their reading skills, so we know the best ways to support any kid in a classroom. Unfortunately, this takes a lot of time away from good teaching moments in the month of August. When there is one teacher and 15-20+ students in a room, it takes a lot of time and effort. With this concern, we envision some time for all K-3 students, in July, to come to school so we can conduct some assessment (not a test) work to know what level kids are at in their current grade level skills so we can:

- Plan for quality teaching in August!
- Create an intervention help plan.
- Allow your child to set goals for their academic growth in a school year.
- Provide parents with information about where their children start and what they can work towards.

This event will start (before school starts) from July 22nd to July 25th from 3:00PM to 7:00PM. Parents can plan for a scheduled appointment in two ways. 1. Paper version (below). 2. On-line version (check emails or on FH website).

Please plan a time before May 20th. If you have not, we will email or send reminder calls. The week prior to the event, we will send a reminder about the appointment.
