Liberty High School Parking Application 2019-2020

Student drivers **must** have a parking permit and observe the following guidelines including those listed in the handbook. Failure to comply with guidelines may result in disciplinary actions including revoking parking permits.

- 1. All vehicles **MUST** be registered and display a valid parking permit if a student is enrolled in one or more classes.
- 2. Students may only parking in the spot that is assigned to them and that corresponds to their parking permit.
- 3. All motor vehicles driven by students must have a parking permit for the current school year. The permit is to hang from your rear view mirror. The speed limit on campus is not to exceed 10 MPH.
- 4. Students are to park in designated areas only. Student lot is on the west side only.
 - a. **NO** parking in the Teacher/Staff lot on the east or north sides of campus.
 - b. **NO** parking on curbs in any parking lot.
- 5. Driving or exiting the campus in a reckless manner is a serious offense and will result in a disciplinary action by Security or Administration. Permits may be suspended or revoked.
- 6. Loitering in the parking lot is **prohibited**; vehicles are not to be used as lockers. Students will be sent back to class.
- 7. Volume of music must be at a reasonable level as to not disturb others. Please be courteous.
- 8. The parking facility is provided by LHS. Neither the school nor the district is responsible for theft or vandalism. **Lock your vehicle.**
- 9. In order to leave campus during the scheduled school day you must have a pass from the Attendance office.
- 10. Taking underclassmen or students not authorized to leave campus will result in suspension or revocation of your parking permit.
- 11. Replacement permits will only be issued by Administration. **Replacement fees are \$15.00.** All vehicle information must be kept current.
- 12. Pedestrians have the right of way.
- 13. As noted in the Liberty High School Student Handbook, vehicles entering or on Liberty High School property may be searched by authorities and/or law enforcement personnel if given "Reasonable Suspicion". Following notice of intent to search, the vehicle will not be permitted to leave the premises without permission.
- 14. The guidelines listed above are in addition to the rules in the LHS handbook.
