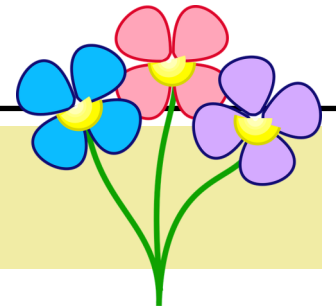

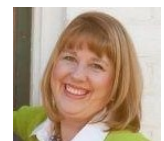
The SunTec Auto Glass Yearly Scholarship Award of \$1500 Deadline 12/15/2021
