Starting with Virtual Instruction

- Your child's teacher will provide you with a schedule of class meeting times that she is "live".
- You can watch recorded sessions at a later time.
- Your child's day will consist of "live lessons", lessons on Florida Virtual, class meetings and projects that your teacher assigns. These things will make up your child's school day and count towards their attendance.

Technology Needed

- A desktop computer or laptop computer works best in the virtual format.
- Chromebooks are also a suitable option.
- Tablets, iPads, and mobile devices may not meet the needs of your child's course and are not recommended.
- We suggest students have a Windows or a Mac-based computer to complete their coursework.
- If your home computer was purchased within the last two to three years, it should work fine.
- We have a limited number of laptops available for checkout.
 Families are financially responsible for loss or damage to the computer.
- In order to participate in Virtual Instruction, internet access/WiFi is required.

How Does My Child Qualify?

- Assessments are given.
