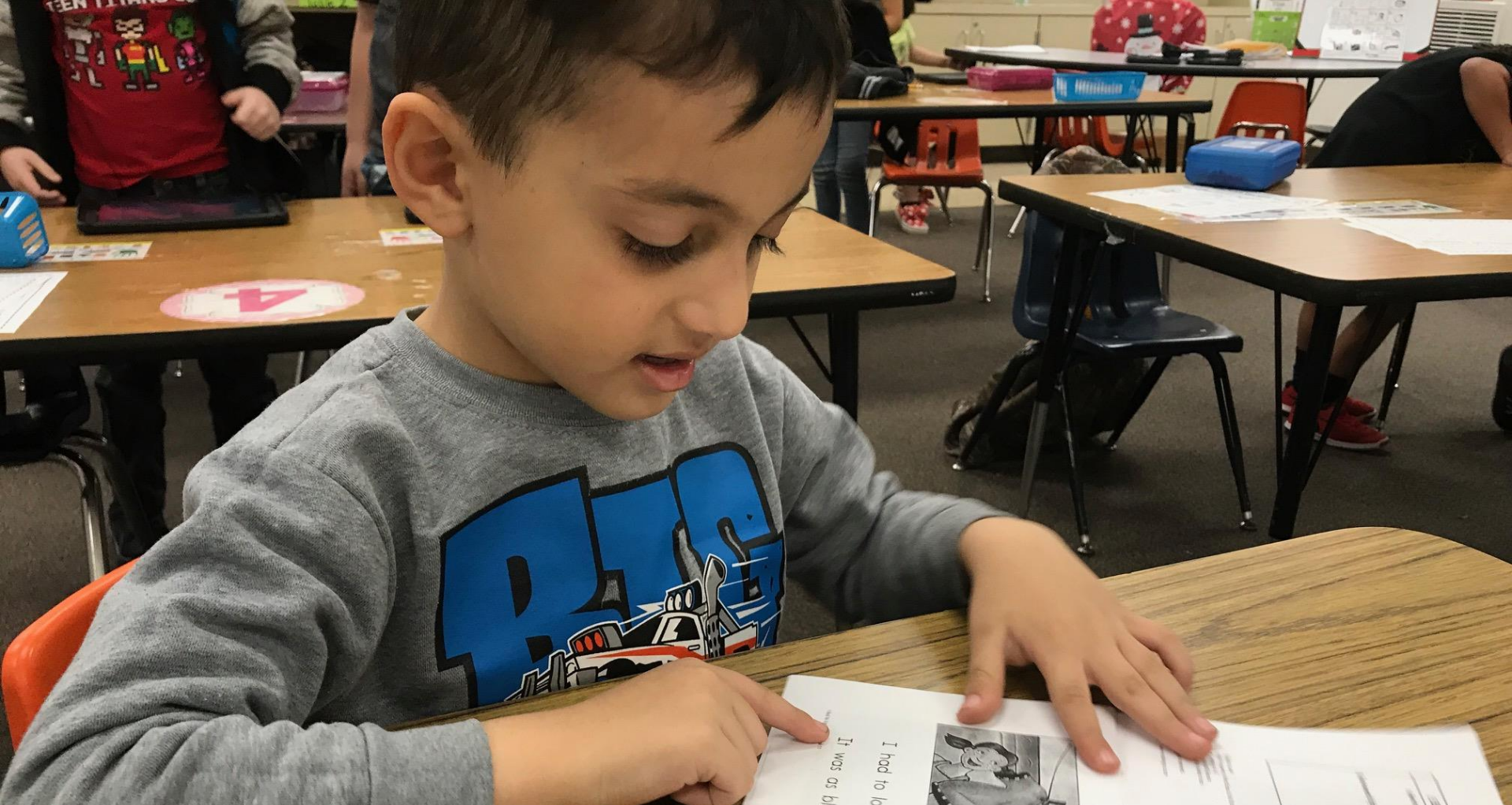

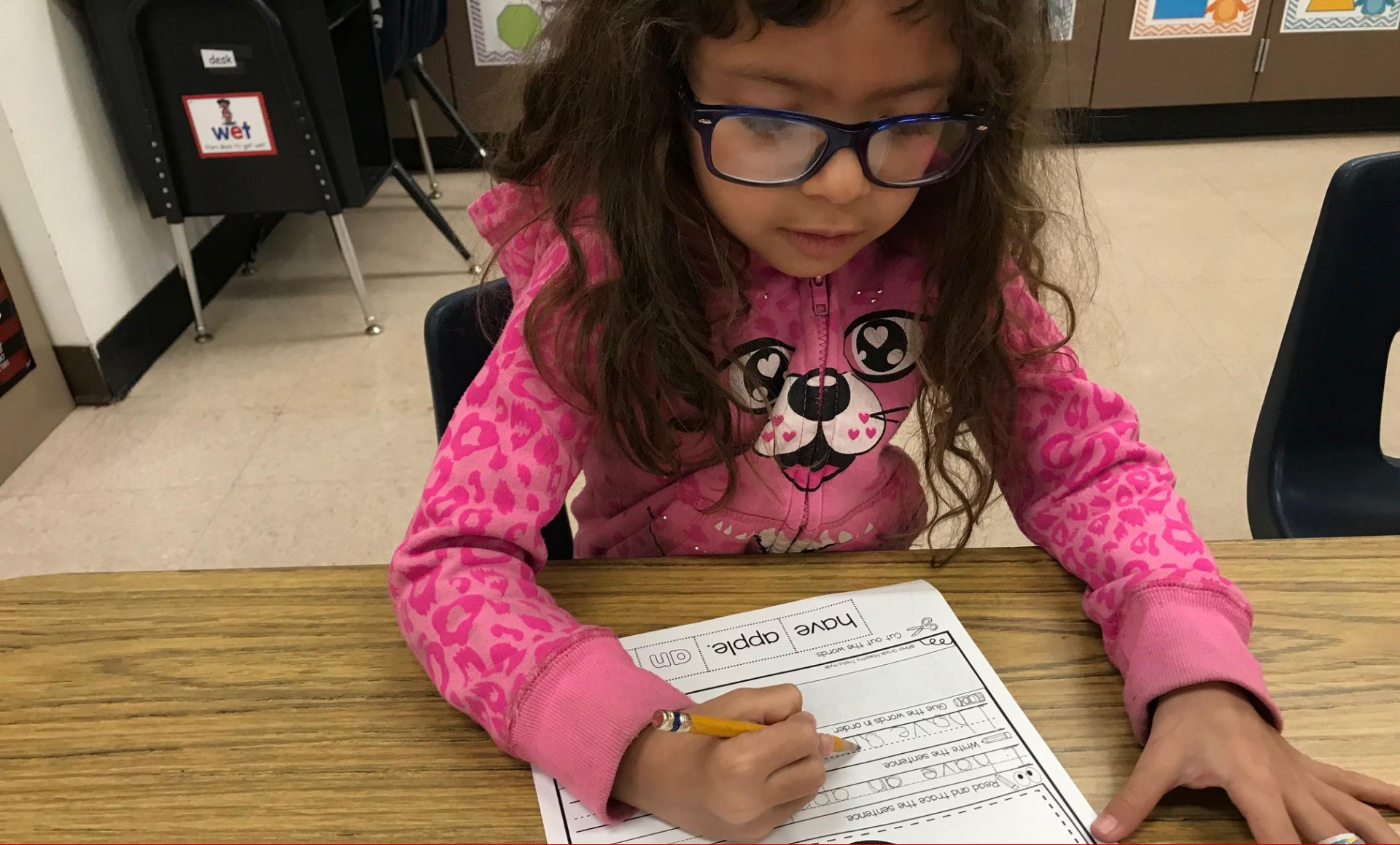

What Reading Looks Like in Kindergarten

Students will learn to identify letters and sounds. They will learn to read sight words and leveled readers. We also do small guided reading groups with them. We utilize Foundations and Benchmark Advanced for ELA.



What Writing Looks Like in Kindergarten

Students will learn proper pencil grip, lower and upper case letter formation. By the end of Kindergarten the goal is for students to write sentences.

What Math Looks Like in Kindergarten



Students will identify numbers 0-100. The goal is for them to add and subtract up to 10 by the end of the year.



What Science/Social Studies Looks Like in Kindergarten

Students are immersed in learning social skills, routines and how to interact with their peers and adults. Science and social studies are also integrated into our daily ELA instruction.
