





Cell Phone Guidelines

Peoria Elementary Cell Phone Guidelines



All student cell phones must be off and away (including earbuds and headphones) unless being used under the direction of a staff member for educational purposes.

Violation 1: Cell phone will be taken to the office by the student. Student may pick up after school.

Violation 2: Cell phone will be taken to the office by the student. Parent will need to pick up after school.

Violation 3: Cell phone will be taken to the office by the student. Parent will need to pick up after school. Student will have a lunch clean up detention assigned.

Violation 4: Cell phone will be taken to the office by the student. Parent will need to pick up after school.

An in-school suspension will be assigned, and a plan developed for the student to be successful with these guidelines. Future incidents will be treated as defiance and may result in out of school suspension.

Bike Rack
