DUO Two-Factor Authentication for Students



Duo is Maricopa Community Colleges' two-factor authentication service providing an extra layer of security to protect against hackers, cyber threats, and any unauthorized access to sensitive data.

A safe and secure way for students to access their online accounts, Duo verifies a student's identity through two factors: a password (something that is known) and a device (something they have, such as a smartphone).

How to Set Up Duo


1. Download the Duo app from Apple or Google Play store (complete in a timely manner).



- a. Go to the Duo website to learn more options if not using a smartphone.
- 2. Follow the Duo set-up instructions. Your student email account (MEID@maricopa.edu) is required.
- 3. Add your phone number.
- 4. Choose your device.
 - a. iPhone or Android Smartphone (more secure & recommended option)
 - b. iPad or Tablet (next best option)
 - c. Traditional cell phone
 - d. Landline
- 5. Log in to a Maricopa system.
- 6. Start using Duo two-factor authentication when prompted through your device choice.

Please note: The device used to setup the Duo account should be the student's device that will be with them each time they need to authenticate Duo when logging into Maricopa systems.

Enrollment Process with Duo



Your authentication as a student is good for 7 days when using the same browser and computer you authenticated. If you attempt to log in to a Maricopa system on another computer, then you will be prompted to authenticate.
