## Centennial High School Parking Rules and Regulations

- Parking is limited to Juniors and Seniors only.
- All vehicles driven by students must have a parking permit for the current school year.
  - You must have a pass for each vehicle. (updated copies of insurance and registration will be need to be provided for each vehicle to the bookstore)
  - The parking permit is to be adhered on the inside driver's side corner (**lower left** corner, near the steering wheel). Permit stickers must be visible at all times.
  - Temporary passes may be issued as needed. Please see the bookstore for pricing details.
- **Students are to park in their designated parking spot**. Spots are assigned on a first come first serve basis.
  - No parking in Teacher/Staff lot on the north side of campus.
  - No parking on any curbs in main parking lot.
  - Violations will be issued. 3<sup>rd</sup> violation will result in a Tow Warning sticker being applied to the windshield.
- Taking underclassmen or students unauthorized to leave campus will result in revocation of your parking permit.
- The following is also prohibited and can result in parking spot being revoked:
  - Excessive speed, squealing tires, passing other vehicles waiting to enter or leave the lot, driving over curbs or any other unsafe driving practice.
  - Failure to comply with campus security directions.
  - Taking up two parking spaces.
  - Parking in a spot other than your assigned one.
  - Driving or exiting campus in a reckless manner is a serious offense and will result in disciplinary action by Security or Administration. Permits will be revoked.
  - Loitering in the parking lot; students will be sent back to class. Vehicles are not to be used as lockers.
  - No tobacco, vapor pens, e-cigarettes, alcohol, or any other substances.
- Volume of music must be at a reasonable level as to not disturb classroom instruction. Please be courteous.
- Pedestrians have the right of way.
- The parking facility is provided by Centennial High School.
  - Neither the school nor the District is responsible for theft, damage or vandalism.
  - Lock your vehicle.
  - The school will assist in any investigation required, but all parking is at the student's/parent's own risk.
- Carpooling is highly suggested and may offer discounted pricing.
- In order to leave campus during the scheduled school day, you must have a pass from the Attendance office.
- Replacement permits are the responsibility of the students. Replacement fees are \$10.00. All vehicle information must be kept current.
- Speed shall not exceed 10 mph on campus.

## Any violation of the Parking Rules and Regulation or School Policy will result in permits being revoked.
