Shortened Online AP Exams

Our Coyotes can complete their 2020 Advanced Placement exams online! The AP exams typically last as long as three hours but will be **reduced to just 45 minutes**. The test dates range from May 11th to May 22nd, and students can complete their exams on a computer or even on some smart phones. **Students must access each exam at the scheduled time indicated in the table below. Please review the dates and times carefully and plan accordingly.**

There are only two exceptions to online testing: AP Seminar and Computer Science Principles students will earn their AP score based entirely on the assigned portfolio, with no exam included.

Resources for Test Prep

Staying Committed

Please join us in encouraging your student to achieve the benefits of a passing AP score: Nearly all colleges and universities grant credit to students who earn qualifying scores on AP exams. Solid AP test scores are among the strongest evidence selective universities and scholarship committees consider when determining admission and financial awards. Finally, the College Board has shortened tests and granted free access to test-prep resources that typically cost money. We hope these changes present a unique opportunity for students to achieve high scores.
