Return to Fall Athletics Ticket Update

As we approach the date of students returning to our campus, the athletic department would like to provide an update on ticket allocation for athletic contests on the Centennial High School campus. Ticket allotment is consistent throughout the Peoria Unified School District's other high schools. Ticket distribution for contests taking place in districts besides PUSD will be communicated during the week of the athletic event.

Ticket distribution will take place during the week of the home athletic event. Updated rosters will be submitted to the high school bookstore by the team's head coach at the beginning of the week. Students will be required to show a Centennial ID to receive two (2) tickets. The student athlete must be on the updated roster to receive tickets. Spectators will not be permitted in the venue without a valid ticket.

Badminton

Two tickets will be given to athletes on the active roster. Team areas will be clearly marked and designated. Seating areas have been marked with physical distancing considerations for spectators.

Cross Country

Due to the nature of cross country meets and invitationals being held at many different venues, communication will be shared with the student athletes and families by the coaches. Information will include local guidelines for spectator attendance.

Centennial High School is fortunate to host the PUSD Cross Country championship again this year. During the planning of the event scheduled for Saturday, October 24th, preparations were made to host the event on the Centennial campus. Athletes will be provided two tickets for the event. Further details will be shared as we get closer to the event.

Football, Spiritline, and Band

Student athletes will be given two tickets for home athletic contests. Varsity Football games will include the Cheer squad and Band while the Junior Varsity Football games will have Cheer participating. Members of the Football, Cheer, and Band squads will all receive two tickets for the game.

Entrance for all games and levels will be located on the northeast side of the stadium.

Golf

Student athletes, coaches, and spectators will continue to follow local course rules regarding COVID-19 procedures. Tickets will not be distributed by Centennial High School. Spectators are encouraged to visit the pro shop before watching a match on the course.

Swim & Dive

After careful consideration, no spectators will be allowed to attend swim and dive events hosted by Peoria high schools. The decision was based on limited seating capacity and spacing for team areas.

Spectator information for swim and dive events taking place in other school districts will be shared by the coaching staff at the appropriate time.

Volleyball

Two tickets will be given to athletes on the active Frosh/Sophomore, Junior Varsity, and Varsity rosters. Since multiple home matches can take place during the same week, athletes will be given the opportunity to pick up all match tickets at one time.

Due to the limited capacity in the gym and all three levels playing the same day, we will ask spectators to enjoy and support their team but allow others to do the same. After the conclusion of your athlete's match, we will ask that spectators exit the gym for others to watch the upcoming match. Seating areas have been designated with physical distancing considerations.
