## IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIRED FOR KINDERGARTEN 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

<u>Dtap</u>: 5 doses, 4 doses are acceptable if the **last dose given @ 4 y.o. or older**.

Polio: 4 doses, 3 doses are acceptable if the last dose given @ 4 y.o. or older.

<u>MMR</u>: (measles, mumps, rubella) 2 doses. *The FIRST given on first birthday or later*. If First dose is before the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday, it is considered a "non-dose" and the child will need a total of 3 doses.

<u>Hep B</u>: 3 doses. First dose @ birth or first month of life, second dose 1 month after first, third dose 4-6+ months after 2<sup>nd</sup> dose (must be no earlier than 24 weeks of age for last dose or will require a 4<sup>th</sup> dose).

Varicella: 1 dose is required. Most kids are getting 2 doses now. 1st dose given around 1 y.o.

\*\*\* These immunizations must be complete before your child starts school in August. \*\*\*

## **Health Office Needs/Rules**

- 1. The nurse needs to know medical diagnoses and medications that child takes (even those taken only at home).
- 2. Medications that are dispensed at school must have paperwork completed & meds must be brought directly to the nurse by a parent. This includes any prescription meds, such as inhalers, SVN treatments, EpiPens, daily meds & over-the-counter medications that you choose to keep at school for your child.
- 3. The nurse has an "emergency" stock of Tylenol that can be given with your permission. We have stock orders for Tylenol only. However, if your child needs Tylenol or Motrin, Advil, etc. on an ongoing basis, you must supply the medication and sign the appropriate paperwork.
- 4. The nurse must have current phone numbers so that you are easily reached when necessary. If your numbers change please be sure to notify me & the front office right away.
- 5. \*If your child is sent home with a fever or vomiting or diarrhea please understand that he/she must stay home the following day & until he/she is fever free, symptom free for 24 hours without medication.
- 6. If you have any questions or concerns feel free to call the nurse @ 623-773-6579. The nurses' hours are from 7:30 to 3:30, daily.
