

Dear Sophomore Coyotes,

The ACT is a nationally-recognized test that assesses your likelihood of succeeding in college-level courses. If you intend to go to a college or university, the ACT may be the most important test you will take as a high school student. That's because students who perform well on the ACT are more likely to be admitted into selective universities and more likely to receive significant scholarship money in Arizona and nationwide.

The Pre-ACT will familiarize sophomores with the content, difficulty, and format of the actual ACT. Evidence indicates that sophomores who complete the Pre-ACT achieve higher ACT scores one year later as juniors. The ACT is required for all juniors; the Pre-ACT is optional for sophomores.

While a grant allows Centennial juniors to complete the ACT free of charge, the Pre-ACT costs \$20.00, which you can pay in the Centennial Bookstore. The \$20 fee covers the costs associated with administering and grading the test.
