State Testing Freshmen and Juniors

You should have received a letter in the mail about Freshman and Junior testing. JUNIORS: you must sign up for which day you plan to test. Do that through this link.

Juniors can take BOTH the ACT and the AZSci on 3/28 OR come two separate days (ACT on 3/30 and AZSci on 4/5).

Freshman have just one test to take: the ACT Aspire. This test will be held on April 3rd.

Here is an excel sheet that may be helpful! You can save a copy and edit this document with your own 4 classes.


