

CAP AND GOWN DISTRIBUTION: FRIDAY, APRIL 24TH

This coming Friday, April 24th, representatives from Jostens will visit the Centennial student parking lot to distribute caps, gowns, and other graduation supply orders from 10AM until 1PM. In order to promote safety and honor social distancing guidelines, families who ordered items should plan to arrive during the following times, according to last name:

10:00am – 11:00am	Last Names A – G
11:00am – 12:00pm	Last Names H – O
12:00pm – 1:00pm	Last Names P – Z

Families who have not ordered a cap and gown can still purchase one on Friday. Jostens will sell them for \$50.00, payable by cash only.

While we do not have any new information to share regarding our postponed graduation ceremony, I continue to hope that circumstances might improve to allow for a traditional commencement. I will certainly share any new information as it becomes available.

Many families are eager to use these supplies to take pictures, send announcements, and generally help you to celebrate a most-important accomplishment. CURBSIDE PICKUP INSTRUCTIONS

Please follow the below instructions and traffic pattern, which will allow for curbside pickup via the driver's side window:

1. Bring your Student ID **or** print your first and last name on an 8.5x11 sheet of paper.
2. From 79th Avenue, **enter the Centennial student parking lot through the south gate**, near the stadium. Turn right near the auxiliary gym to drive toward the cafeteria. Turn right and retrieve your items in front of the main office.
3. Display the ID or printed page so that Jostens can retrieve your order and bring it to your car.
4. Finally, **exit through the 79th Avenue north gate**.
