## PROM CODE OF CONDUCT

As the 2025 Prom approaches, we are looking forward to a very special and meaningful night. To achieve this, we are asking for your cooperation. All participants at the 2025 Prom must abide by the following code of conduct:

- ❖ The Centennial High School Prom is a school sponsored event. Students will always abide by all Centennial rules and policies.
- ❖ There will be NO RE-ENTRY. Once you exit the Prom venue, you must leave the premises.
- ❖ Students determined to be in violation of the PUSD Alcohol, Tobacco and other Drug policies will be subject to arrest, removal from the dance, and consequences as per the policy. Any senior who violates the drug and alcohol policy at the Prom may not be permitted to participate in graduation ceremonies. Participation in graduation is a privilege not a right.
- ❖ Please dress appropriately. This is a **formal** dance. **Ladies:** Dresses may not be cut too low in the front or in the back. They may not expose a bare midriff and they may not be excessively short. **Gentlemen:** No shorts or t-shirts. Tux, suit, dress slacks and dress shirts are appropriate. All students are expected to abide by the normal dress code guidelines regarding prohibited attire.
- ❖ Students are expected to dance in a respectable manner. Dancing that is inappropriate, overly sexual in nature, or creates unsafe conditions is not allowed. This includes, but is not limited to:
  - Inappropriate touching
  - Removal of clothing (including removal of shirts for boys)
  - Dresses/Skirts lifted up
  - Grinding movements
  - Bending over in front of another student and/or placing hands on floor

School officials reserve the right to make decisions on suitable dancing and individuals who engage in the above-mentioned behaviors may be removed from the dance.

- ❖ Since this is a school function, all vehicles attending the Prom will be subject to search at any time.
