- Begin work on your Education Career Action Plan (ECAP) by exploring and learning more about your interests and skills.
- Explore and research different careers that interest you.
- Identify your strengths, what are you good at?
- Identify your interests.
- Learn how career success is related to strengths, skills and interests.
- Learn and practice collaboration (teamwork), communication and critical thinking skills.
- Explore high school opportunities available to you (i.e. CTE, Arts, West-MEC, MET, etc.).
- Relate high school course planning to career and post-secondary opportunities.
- Explore different technology tools that can help you explore careers and career pathways.
- Explore how personal behaviors and communication impact the workplace.
- Start thinking about the lifestyle you want as an adult, how does your career choice impact that?
