Dear Mustang Students and Parents,

The Arizona State Board of Education has mandated state testing to all 11th grade students. On Tuesday, April 1st, the ACT will be administered to **all juniors**. On Wednesday, April 2nd, the AzSci test will be administered to **all juniors**. These exams must be taken on school-issued laptops.

Testing Information

• All state testing information can be found on our school website under the ACADEMICS tab.

<u>Schedule:</u>

- The morning bus pick up for 11th grade test takers will be normal times.
- All 10th and 12th graders <u>will not attend school</u> and will complete learning online from home on April 1st and 2nd. Students will be provided with assignments from their teachers that they will turn in electronically. Juniors (and freshmen taking the ACT ASPIRE) will be exempt from the class work since they will be testing on both days.

Test Prep:

- Optional ACT Test Prep Sessions will be offered in March. A separate flyer will be sent out at a later date for students to sign up.
- All juniors will attend a Spring State Testing meeting on during school the first week of March to learn more about the two days of testing and what to do to be prepared.

Before Testing:

- Students who may be attending college need to create an account on **myact.org**. to access their score as soon as they are available and send their score to four colleges of their choice for free. Students can sign up for a workshop to complete this step. It is strongly recommended to attend the workshop rather than completing it on their own at home as there are some questions about transcripts, courses, and other details a school official will be able to help with. The link & QR code to sign up for this workshop will be given to students at the Spring State Testing Meeting in March.
- Room assignments for both testing days will be posted on Monday, March 31st outside by grand staircase.

Day of the Test:

- Arrive in assigned testing room before 7:20am. Students who arrive late will be sent home.
- Must have school ID or StudentVue to check into testing room.
- Students may bring an approved calculator for the ACT Math test.
 - ACT CALCULATOR POLICY
- Students may bring plug-in headphones for the AzSCI test only.
- Phones, airpods, and smart watches will not be permitted during testing, breaks, or lunch. Students found with any electronic devices at any point during the testing day will have their test invalidated and the item will be turned into the office for parent pickup.

Students must have a school-issued laptop, fully charged for testing. It is extremely important that students sign into the computer while on school Wi-Fi prior to the testing dates to ensure that all updates have been installed.
