Back To School Helpful Safety Tips

We are a community, **A TEAM**, and I need your help. As we get closer to having students on campus I would like share some safety tips to help the year go smoothly and safely.

- While driving, bike riding and/or walking on or around school campus, slow down, be vigilant and exercise patience during the drop off and pick-up process. -Be safe-
- When driving around Kellis High School or on campus follow all traffic signs and devices. Obey the posted speed limits (25 MPH on the roadway and 10 MPH on campus), stop at all stop signs and yield to all pedestrians. -Adhere to traffic laws-
- Pedestrians must also follow all traffic signs and devices, use the crosswalks and pay attention when walking near traffic. -Your phone can wait-
- Immediately report all suspicious, concerning and criminal activity to any school staff member or School Resource Officer. -If you SEE or HEAR something, say something!-
- Each student is responsible for taking care of their own personal property. Keep your personal items on your person (in your control) or in your backpack and keep backpack on your person (in your control) or keep your personal items properly locked in a locker, which is (in your control). -Lock It or Lose It!-
