Maricopa Grant Priority Deadline August 25, 2023 Maricopa Grant Final Deadline September 8, 2023 Dual Enrollment Next Steps Form Submission Deadline September 8, 2023 Self Register Deadline September 8, 2023 Dual Enrollment Payment Deadline September 20, 2023 Last day to request a refund September 22, 2023

- <u>Maricopa Grant application</u> is online. Tuition assistance is available for those who qualify (must be a U.S. citizen and meet the <u>income guidelines</u>) and demonstrate financial need. Funding is based on the availability of funds. Use your MEID@maricopa.edu and password to login. Paper applications NOT accepted. Don't have a MEID and password? <u>Apply for Admissions</u> online to create your college student account. For more information, go to the <u>Online Admissions Guide</u>.
- <u>PCPP Scholarship Application</u> is for CFS/ECH courses at Glendale Community College. The Professional Career Pathway Project (PCPP) is a scholarship funded by the Department of Economic Security Child Care Administration through Federal Child Care Development Block Grant Funds. If the student is currently working in the field of early childhood (in family child care or center based programs), PCPP will pay college tuition for up to 24 credits a year. Application must be submitted before payment deadline.
- <u>Dual Enrollment Class List Information</u> to view your high school's Dual Enrollment classes and take note of the class number. You will need this for the Next Steps form.<u>Dual Enrollment</u>.
- <u>Next Steps form</u> is an online form. Use your MEID@maricopa.edu and password to login to submit your Dual Enrollment class request.

• College Class Placement Testing

- EdReady placement test is a free, online tool that will be used for all college class placement testing. Use your MEID@maricopa.edu and password to login. How do you know if your college class requires a placement test? It will be listed on your high school <u>Class Lists</u> under Prerequisites. You may also find more information from the <u>Dual</u> <u>Enrollment Class Prerequisite</u> guide and <u>Testing Guide</u>.
- Free Online Library Resources: Students have access to free online library resources.
- <u>Kurzweil Program</u>: Kurzweil can assist students in the following areas: reading, vocabulary, writing, study skills and test taking skills. Students must be registered for college class(s) (Dual Enrollment) and are free to the student!
- <u>College Accommodations</u>: Dual Enrollment students who seek accommodations, must apply with our college's <u>Disability and Resources Services</u>.
