This timeline is up-to-date as of publication; however, there will be additional events, and dates as the year progresses. Be sure to check your student email, listen to announcements, visit the Career Center, and check the Guidance Website frequently throughout the school year.

August

- August 30th – Sept 1st – Counselor presentations
- Meet with your counselor and review ECAP-be sure you are on track to graduate.
- Sign-up to get Remind Messages from Guidance if not already receiving them (text @2023-6 to 81010)
- Register for ACT (act.org) and/or SAT (collegeboard.com) retakes for those who are interested in university admission and scholarships
- Schedule appointment to have picture taken at Grads Photography for yearbook (you do not have to purchase pictures from them). online at <https://bit.ly/lhsgradphoto> or call 623-580-4723
- Begin applying to colleges of your choice

September

- University and out of state university students: finalize list of potential colleges and check application deadlines. Apply, Apply, Apply! (Do not wait for test scores)
- Sept. 5th: Labor Day (No school)
- September 26th - UofA Visit @ 10am in Library – must sign up in the Career Center
- September 27th - NAU Visit @ 10am in Library – must sign up in the Career Center
- September 28th - ASU Visit @ ____ am in Library – must sign up in the Career Center
- September 30th - GCU Visit @ 10am in Library – must sign up in the Career Center

October

- Oct. 1st: Complete university applications, especially out-of-state. Check colleges and know deadlines.
- Oct. 1st: Get your federal student Aid I.D. number and complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) @ www.fafsa.ed.gov (money is first come first serve)
- Request transcripts through your Major Clarity account
- Order caps, gowns, and other graduation supplies - <https://bit.ly/lhsgrad23>
- Order yearbook and parents can do Senior AD in yearbook - <https://bit.ly/lhs23yearbook> (\$10 off if you order before November)
- October 10th: Columbus Day (No school)
- October 11th-14th: Homecoming Week
- October 15th: Homecoming Dance

November

- If living on campus for college, check housing deadlines and deposit due dates
- Continue applying for colleges and universities if you have not completed them
- November 11th: Veteran's Day/No school
- November 21st – 25th: Fall Break/No school

December

- Complete College Applications

- December 17th – Senior yearbook picture due @ Grads Photography - **NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE. If you do not get headshot by this date, you will not be in the yearbook.** <https://bit.ly/lhsgradphoto>
- December 21st-22nd: Semester one final exams -- Early release – 10:20 a.m.
- December 22nd: Winter Break begins

January

- January 9th: Second semester begins
- January 16th: MLK Day/No school
- Begin collecting and submitting scholarship award letters even if you are not attending that college (submit to Career Center Specialist)

February

- Continue collecting and submitting scholarship award letters even if you are not attending that college (submit to Career Center Specialist)
- February 14th - ASVAB Test (for those interested in military; sign-up in Career Center)
- February 20th: Presidents' Day/No school

March

- Continue collecting and submitting scholarship award letters even if you are not attending that college (submit to Career Center Specialist)
- Complete application, placement test, and register for classes for community college admittance
- March 20th – 24th: Spring Break/No school

April

- Begin preparation for AP exams if you are taking them in May
- April 6th – Jostens Cap/Gown delivery
- April 15th: *DEADLINE* all scholarship award letters to Career Center Specialist
- April 21st: April Break- no school
- April 22nd: PROM
- April 27th - Senior meeting
- April 28th: All outstanding debts paid to bookstore and library

May

- May 1st: All outside credits/transcripts due
- May 1st - May 12th: AP Testing window
- May 4th: senior check out form is available – more information to come in May
- May 4th: PUSD senior exit survey available – link will be sent via Remind
- May 9th: Senior Award Ceremony
- May 18-19th: Senior final exams
- May 19th : Senior Last Day of school
