- GPA in competency courses

Barack Obama Scholars

Program

- Top 25% in class or 3.00 GPA in competency courses or ACT 22* or SAT Reasoning 1040* or at the discretion of the University
- Degree – Seeking and Full-Time
- Complete FAFSA by March 1st
- Eligible to Receive Federal Pell Grant
- Member of a family whose adjusted gross income is <\$42,400

*ASU does not require the writing portion of these tests.

College Attainment Grant

- Member of a family whose adjusted gross income is <\$42,400
- Eligible to receive Federal Pell Grant
- Full Time

Scholarships

Lumberjack Scholarship

(tuition)

- 3.5 GPA in core classes (no grades below "B")
- No Retakes or deficiencies
- Renewal Criteria must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA

President's Scholarship

(\$8,000 per year)

- ACT/SAT Scores or at the discretion of the University
- Core GPA 3.5-4.0

Dean's with Distinction

Scholarship

(\$6,500 per year)

- 3.4-3.49 Unweighted Core GPA
- ACT/SAT Scores or at the discretion of the University

Dean's Tuition Scholarship

(\$5,000 per year)

- ACT/SAT Scores or at the discretion of the University
- Core GPA 3.0-3.39

Opportunity Scholarship

(\$2,500 per year)

- ACT/SAT Scores or at the discretion of the University
- Core GPA 2.90 – 2.99

Scholarships

Wildcat Excellence Tuition

Award (\$750 - \$12,500)

- Based on 6th semester transcript core unweighted GPA
- ACT/SAT scores or at the discretion of the University.
- Awards not available for students starting in spring.

Arizona Assurance Scholars

Program

- Have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC), as calculated by the FAFSA, of 0 (zero)*
- Eligible to receive Federal Pell Grant
- Complete FAFSA
- Un-Weighted 3.0 GPA – in 1st six semesters of H.S.
- Full – Time
- Will be invited for consideration by email

Pell Pledge Grant (Tuition)

- Member of a family whose adjusted gross income is <\$42,400
- Admitted to Arizona Main Campus only
- Hold a 2.50 core 6th semester high school GPA
