- Your grades

- 4 ENGLISH CREDITS
- 4 MATH CREDITS
- 3 LAB SCIENCE CREDITS
- 1 PERSONAL FITNESS CREDIT
- PLUS 12 ELECTIVE CREDITS = 28 CREDITS

PUSD uses an unweighted G.P.A. system
