Dear Parents of the class of 2022!

It's already that time!! This week, your student will begin selecting their <u>JUNIOR</u> courses for the 2020-2021 school year! All sophomores will have the opportunity to enter their own course requests thru their StudentVue portal in Synergy. We will need your help at home to ensure that this process goes smoothly, and that your son/daughter is reviewing these selections with you! Below are some steps to get your son/daughter ready for the registration process.

- 1) Please work with your student on their course selections and make sure they've filled out their paper registration form completely.
- 2) For all the registration information, including the PowerPoint we reviewed with your student, visit our school website: https://www.peoriaunified.org/Centennial
 - a. Go to Academics then click on "GUIDANCE" then click on "Sophomore Class"
 - b. You will find the presentation, the proposed courses for the 2020-21 school year, and a file with all the course descriptions for all courses offered in PUSD
 - c. To view the on-line registration video, click "Online Registration Guide Video"
- 3) **Sign** the back of the form, both you and your student.

When you and your student have selected courses (*with course ID numbers*) and entered them on the paper registration form, please have your student log in to their StudentVue, on a computer as the app does not work for this, and complete the on-line registration process (directions are in the folder or on our website).

The last step for your student will be a small group meeting with his/her counselor the week of **October 28**th. All students will be assigned a day to come to the library to:

- 1) Turn in their signed paper registration form and green folder
- 2) Verify that on-line course requests are accurate (courses should be already entered)
- 3) Ask any questions they may have about their courses or graduation plan.

We understand you and your student will have questions during this process. Please carefully review all of the materials on the website available to you. Your student will have the opportunity to ask questions and receive feedback on their selections when they meet with us. If you'd like to reach your counselor, email is the best means at this time.
