

Open Enrollment Process for Eighth Graders Currently Attending a PUSD School

Is your residence in a high school attendance zone different from the high school zone your child's elementary school feeds into <u>and</u> you want your child to attend the high school that serves the elementary school your child currently attends? (Example: you live in the Cactus High School attendance zone, but your child goes to an elementary school that feeds into Centennial High School.)	Yes	An Open Enrollment Application must be approved for your child to attend the high school that his/her elementary school automatically feeds into. Submit your application by the first Friday in February, to the elementary school your child currently attends. You will be notified by the first Friday in April if your application is approved.
Is your residence in the same high school attendance zone that your child's elementary school feeds into, <u>but</u> you want your child to attend a different PUSD high school? (Example: you live in the Cactus High School attendance zone and your child goes to Foothills which feeds into Cactus, but you want your child to go to Centennial High School.)	Yes	An Open Enrollment Application must be approved for your child to attend a different PUSD high school. Submit your request no later than the first Friday in February, <i>to the high</i> <i>school you want your child to attend.</i> You will be notified by the first Friday in April if your application is approved.
Is your residence in the same high school attendance zone that your child's elementary school feeds into, <u>and</u> you want your child to attend your high school of residence? (Example: you live in the Oakwood Elem./Cactus High School Attendance zone; your child goes to Foothills and you want your child to go to Cactus High School.)	No	An Open Enrollment Application is not needed for students attending the high school designated for their residence.

Please be sure the application is complete and signed when submitted. Incomplete applications will be returned.



Peoria Unified School District High School Feeder Schools

The high school a student attends is based on the address of the parents/legal guardians, not on the elementary school the student attended. Eighth graders attending an elementary school on an open enrollment will be considered for open enrollment to attend the high school that his/her elementary school feeds into. If the elementary school feeds into two different high schools, you have the option of attending either one of those high schools.
