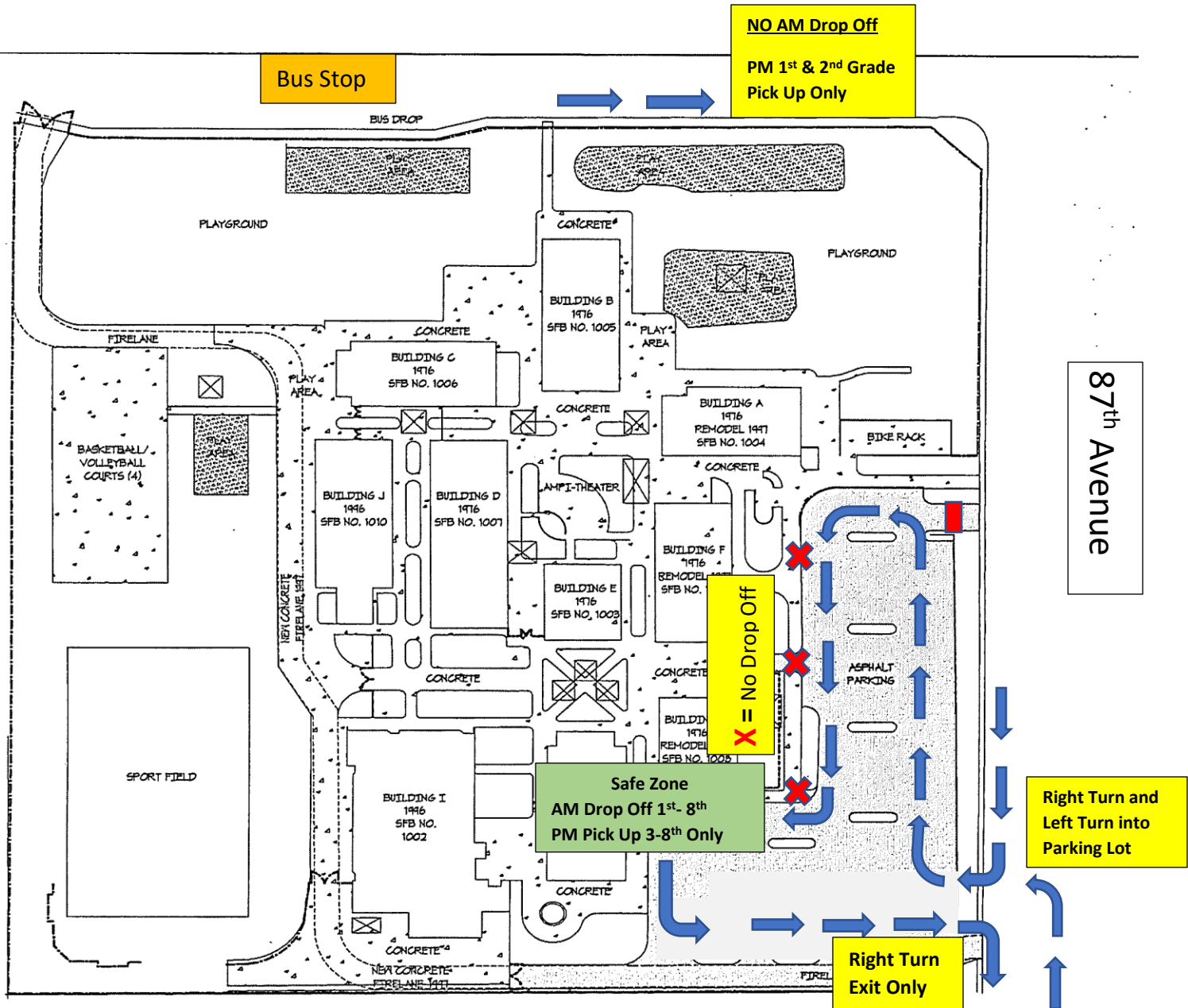


Mountain View



Students Walking/Riding Bikes or Scooters to and from School

Mountain View/North Side Entrance onto Campus

- Students who live North of the school will enter/exit campus through the gate by the bus drop off zone on Mountain View. The front gate will not be open this year.
- Students must walk bikes, scooters, skateboards, etc. through the crosswalk and while on campus.

South Side Entrance (87th Ave.) onto Campus

- Students who live South of the school must enter/exit campus using the fenced-in sidewalk. Students are not permitted to walk through the parking lot.
- Students must walk bikes, scooters, skateboards, etc. through the crosswalk and while on campus.

Student Drop Off/Pick Up Zones

West Parking Lot Zone (Safe Zone)

- **AM Drop off for Kindergarten – 8th Grade.** Students must be dropped off in the safe zone so that they can enter the campus and go directly to the cafeteria for breakfast. All students will receive a free breakfast and must be dropped off starting at 7:40 a.m. Breakfast will be served 7:40 a.m. – 8:00 a.m. All classes start at 8:00 a.m. for Kindergarten through Eighth Grade. If your student arrives on campus after 8:00 they will need to enter through the front office to pick up a late pass to go to class. We want all students to have the opportunity to eat breakfast at school, so please make sure to be on time to school.
 - **August 7th – 9th Only for Kindergarten - Kindergarten students need to be brought to the classrooms first. Teachers will check in students and then walk them to breakfast. Please park and walk your students to the kindergarten gate area.**

AM Drop Off on Mountain View is prohibited. All students must be dropped off in the new designated safe zone.

PM Pick Up for Kindergarten

- All parents must park and pick up students from the classroom. Please enter the gate by the Kindergarten building
 - A1 – Pick up for Smith and Miranda
 - A2 – Pick up for Keegan and Holladay

Safe Pick Up Zones

- **PM Pick Up on Mountain View is for 1st & 2nd Grade Only.** The Exception to the rule is If your 1st or 2nd Grader has an older sibling(s), the older students can join their younger siblings at this pick-up zone.
- **PM Pick Up for 3rd – 8th Grade.** Students must be picked up in the safe pick up zone. Students will not be permitted to walk through the parking lot to get into a vehicle. If you do not want to stay in the pickup car line, you will need to park and use the designated crosswalk areas to enter campus and pick up your child. Staying in the pickup car line will be the fastest and safest way to pick up your child from school.
