

## **Completing a GCU Dual Enrollment Application**


Go to <a href="https://apply.gcu.edu/Account/Register">https://apply.gcu.edu/Account/Register</a> on your computer or mobile device.
 You only need to fill out the fields that have a red asterisk (\*), you can skip all other fields.
 It is important that you select "Dual High School Student" when it asks how you will be attending.



2. Continue through the application, answering all questions to the best of your ability. When you get to the page that asks about you interest in an undergraduate degree at GCU, please note that this is asking if you are interested in attending GCU full time after you graduate from high school. If you select yes, you may receive contact from another representative at the university to discuss scholarship opportunities and other programs that may be of interest to you. If you are not interested, no worries, we will still work with you to take advantage of the dual enrollment program.



3. Continue through to the end, and make sure that you click the final "Submit Application" button.



4. Once the application is submitted, you will see the following page. Form here, you are all set and do not have to do anything else to receive contact from the dual enrollment team. You can, however, get a head start on the registration process by printing off the Parental Authorization Form and Student Information Release Form listed here or by taking the online placement exam. Please note, all English or math courses do require a placement exam to be completed by a student.
