

How to Install Moodle App (Apple)

Note: Make sure you have enrolled in the eCampus Moodle course via a desktop or laptop device before accessing your course via the app. You will need to access the course via a desktop or laptop if course content in the app is limited. Screenshots may differ depending on your iOS version.


The Moodle app is available in the Apple app store. Enter Moodle in your search to find the Q Moodle Cancel app. Moodle Moodle official a... Open the app and enter https://ecampus.pusd11.net as the site address Connect to Mo... and then click Connect. mood Please enter the URL of your Moodle site. - 5-Contents tab contains all your course content (e.g., course lessons). Scroll down on the app to see all content.
- 6-Participants list
- 7-Right arrow will reveal grades for assignments, quizzes, etc. Note: You should always refer to StudentVUE for official course grades.


You also have a series of buttons at the bottom of the app.

Messages-Message your teacher. These messages are sent to your teacher's email so he/she may reply to your student email account. Notifications-See a list of alerts sent by your teacher via the mobile app.
