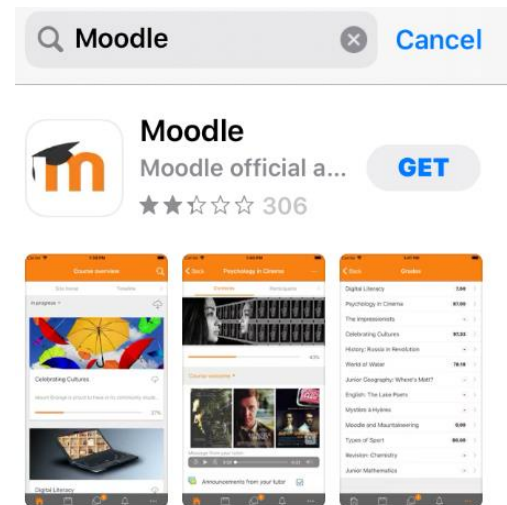


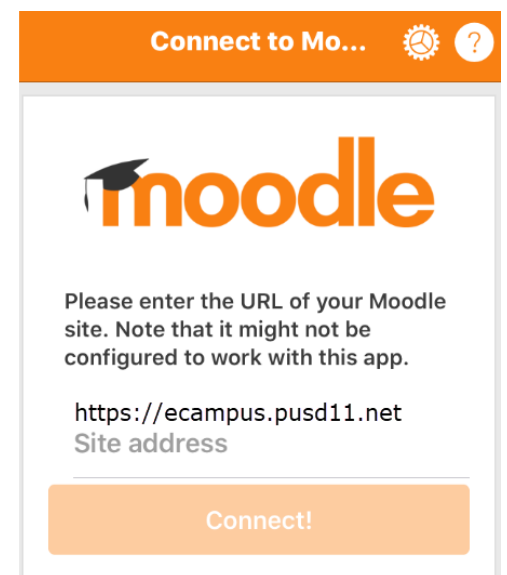
## How to Install Moodle App (Apple)

Note: Make sure you have enrolled in the eCampus Moodle course via a desktop or laptop device before accessing your course via the app. You will need to access the course via a desktop or laptop if course content in the app is limited. Screenshots may differ depending on your iOS version.

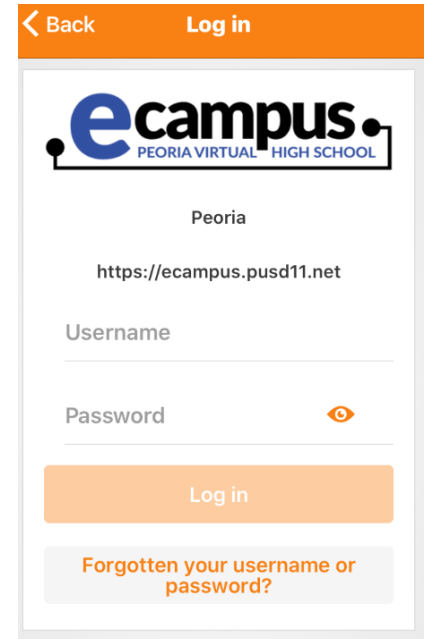
The Moodle app is available in the Apple app store. Enter Moodle in your search to find the app.



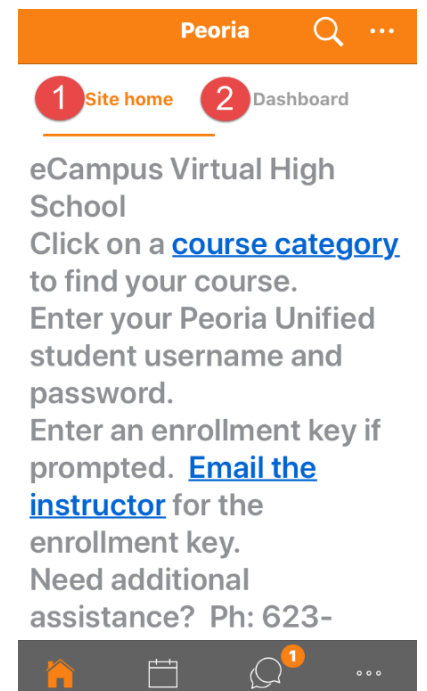
Open the app and enter <https://ecampus.pusd11.net> as the site address and then click Connect.



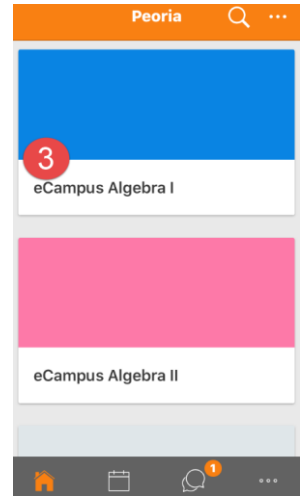
Enter your district username and password and click Login in.



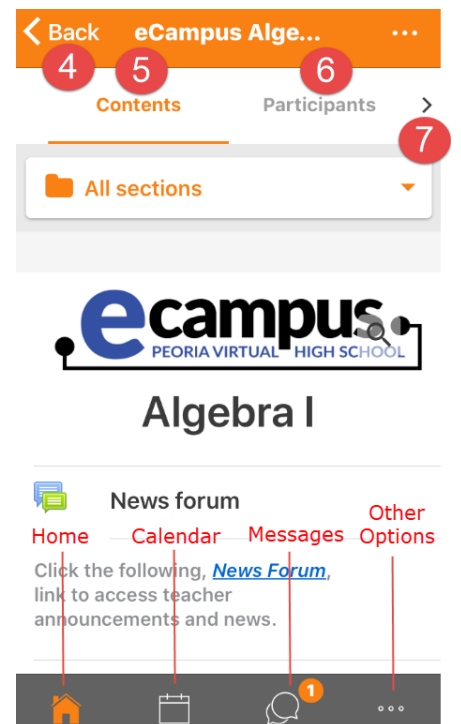
There are two main tabs: Site home (1) and Dashboard (2). Click the Dashboard tab to see the courses you have enrolled in.



Click on the course name (3) to enter the course.

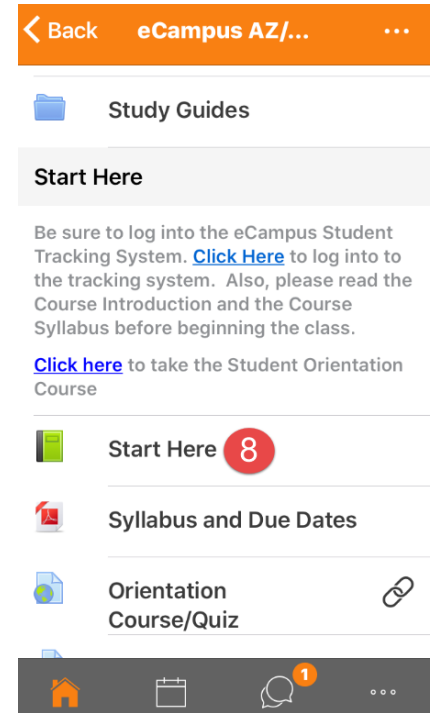


You can now navigate to various options with the app.  
 4-Back button at top left will take you back to previous screen.  
 5-Contents tab contains all your course content (e.g., course lessons). Scroll down on the app to see all content.  
 6-Participants list  
 7-Right arrow will reveal grades for assignments, quizzes, etc. Note: You should always refer to StudentVUE for official course grades.



You also have a series of buttons at the bottom of the app.  
*Home*-Will take you back to main course page or Dashboard.  
*Calendar*-View a calendar to plan your work schedule  
*Messages*-Message your teacher. These messages are sent to your teacher’s email so he/she may reply to your student email account.  
*Notifications*-See a list of alerts sent by your teacher via the mobile app.  
*Three dots*-Reveal other options

Scrolling down the Contents section of the app will show all the course content. Most of the course content will be contained in small green books. In the example on the right, you would click on the Start Here book (8) to view important lessons on how to begin your course.



Once you are inside a book, you can use the top arrow (9) to navigate the lessons.
