SAT & PSAT www.collegeboard.org	PSAT is offered at SMHS in the Fall of your Junior Year.	PSAT prepares students for SAT tests. Must take this test to compete for some National Scholarships. SAT exams are accepted by most colleges and universities. Check your school of interest.
ACT <u>www.act.org</u>	ACT is taken by ALL juniors at SMHS during the Spring of your junior year for free.	Accepted by most colleges and universities. Check your schools of interest. If you need to <i>re-test</i> go to <u>www.act.org</u> Sign up deadline is 5-6 weeks prior to test date.
